Stage Manager/Tech Director

• You have 4 crew members and 1 hour. A set piece has a large scratch in the paint, 2 tutus need to be made, and a candlestick used in the play has broken. Also, a cable is missing for the light board. Write a short explanation of how you would assign and complete your to-do list while making sure every job is done correctly and efficiently.

Set/Props Crew

• Draw a backdrop for a scene in this play OR design (draw) a magical book prop used by one of the characters. It must be on an 8.5" X 11" sheet of paper and must be colored. You must label your drawing either "Backdrop" or "Book."

Hair/Makeup Crew

• Imagine a character who lives on a magical deserted island and design the makeup and/or hair for that character as if you are going to use it for the play. You may either draw it on an 8.5" X 11" sheet of paper, or actually do it on yourself/someone else and take a photograph.

Light Crew

• Write one short paragraph describing how you would light the deserted island during the day, and how you would light it at night. Also answer this question: How does lighting affect the mood of a scene?

Sound Crew

• Create a playlist of 6 songs that would fit the theme of a magical deserted island. Write a sentence or two for each song explaining why you chose it.
